Susanna Allés-Torrent is Associate Professor in the Department of Modern Languages and Literatures at the University of Miami. She specializes in Medieval and Early Modern Iberia, life-writing, translation studies, textual scholarship and philology, and she explores several aspects of digital humanities, especially, scholarly digital editions and electronic text analysis. Her first book *Las Vitae Hannibalis et Scipionis de Donato Acciaiuoli, traducidas por Alfonso de Palencia (1491)* (Brepols, 2014) explores the textual and cultural tradition of two biographies written in Latin by the Italian humanist Donato Acciaiuoli, and translated in Spanish by Alfonso de Palencia. She is currently working on a digital project, the *Archive of Biographical Writings in Medieval and Early Modern Iberia*, and on a second monograph on collections of lives in fifteenth-century Spain.
