Abdulhamit Arvas is Assistant Professor of English at the University of Pennsylvania. His work on early modern sexualities, genders, race, cross-cultural encounters, and sexual politics in modern Turkey has appeared or is forthcoming in journals including English Literary Renaissance, Journal of Early Modern Cultural Studies, Shakespeare Survey, GLQ: A Journal of Lesbian and Gay Studies, and in edited collections such as The Postcolonial World, The Cambridge History of Gay and Lesbian Literature, England's Asian Renaissance, and A Companion to Global Shakespeares. He has co-edited of the tenth anniversary issue of postmedieval: a journal of medieval cultural studies. He is currently completing a book manuscript that explores English and Ottoman sexualities with a focus on abductions of beautiful boys in the Mediterranean during the sixteenth and early seventeenth centuries.
