

Lisette Balabarca is Associate Professor of Spanish at Siena College (Loudonville, NY). Her general academic field is Early Modern Hispanic Studies, and her research area is, specifically, *Morisco* and *Aljamiado* Literature and the texts produced by *moriscos* during their final expulsion from the Iberian Peninsula in the 17th century (1609-1614). Her research interests and publications also include Early Modern Spanish Picaresque Novels and Travel Literature. Among her publications are “*Viaje de Turquía: la representación de los musulmanes en un diálogo del siglo XVI*” (in *Hispania Félix*), “El enemigo musulmán en *El Abencerraje: Abindarráez, los moriscos y la personificación de la derrota*” (in *e-Humanista/Conversos*) and “‘Toda obra loa y alaba a su Hacedor’: transgresión, subversión y sarcasmo en *La Lozana andaluza* de Francisco Delicado” (in *Romance Notes*). She’s currently working on a comparative study of religious polemics between Old Christians and *moriscos* in 17th century Spain and Tunisia after the expulsion of the latter.
