

Giuseppe Gerbino is professor of historical musicology at Columbia University, New York. He has published on the Italian madrigal, the relationship between music and language in the early modern period, early opera, and Renaissance theories of cognition and sense perception. He is the author of *Canoni ed Enigmi: Pier Francesco Valentini e l'artificio canonico nella prima metà del Seicento* (Rome, 1995), and *Music and the Myth of Arcadia in Renaissance Italy* (Cambridge, 2009), which won the 2010 Lewis Lockwood Award of the American Musicological Society. He is currently at work on a book on music and mind in Renaissance Italy.
