Claire Gilbert is Associate Professor of Early Modern History at Saint Louis University. She trained in late medieval and early modern European history at UCLA and has since pursued work in the social history of translation and linguistics, with an emphasis on the western Mediterranean between the fifteenth and nineteenth centuries. Her publications include a book, *In Good Faith: Arabic Translation and Translators in Early Modern Spain* (University of Pennsylvania Press, 2020), and a variety of peer-reviewed articles and book chapters exploring translation and language politics in Europe and North Africa. At Saint Louis University, she teaches graduate and undergraduate courses on European and World History.
