George Gorse holds a PhD from Brown and is Viola Horton Professor of Art History at Pomona College. He has held numerous fellowships such as Bogliasco, Huntington, NEH, Villa i Tatti, ACLS, and the Institute for Advanced Studies at Princeton. He has published on Medieval and Renaissance Genoa: the Villa Doria in Renaissance Genoa, French and Hapsburg triumphal entries into sixteenth-century Genoa, the portraits and artistic patronage of admiral Andrea Doria, the Strada Nuova as a "theatre" for old and new noble families in Renaissance Genoa, and (most recently) the Virgin Mary as "Queen of Genoa" in 1637.
