

Dr. Daniel K. Gullo is the Joseph S. Micallef Director of the Malta Study Center at the Hill Museum and Manuscript Library. He also currently serves as the project director for HMML's Resources for the Description of Manuscripts from Understudied Christian and Islamic Traditions, including the project director for the new HMML Authority File. From 2015–2020, he was the Director of the vHMML project, creating one of the world's largest repositories for digitized Mediterranean manuscripts and archives.
