With Spanish archaeologist Sebastian Celestino, she recently published *Tartessos: Indigenous Peoples and Phoenician Colonists in the Iberian Peninsula* (Oxford University Press, 2016; rev. expanded version in Spanish, 2020). She has co-edited *The Oxford Handbook of the Phoenician and Punic Mediterranean* (2019), with Brian Doak. Her next book on *Phoenicians and the Making of the Mediterranean* will offer a critical discussion on the role of the Phoenicians during the so-called “orientalizing” period across the Mediterranean (Forthcoming, Harvard University Press).
