Paige Milligan is the current Andrew W. Mellon Postdoctoral Fellow in Arabic at Bowdoin College. She completed her PhD from the University of Michigan in 2022 with her dissertation titled, "After Al-Andalus / Palestine: Resistance and Collaboration in Morisco and Palestinian Literatures." Her research focuses on the comparative study of early modern Morisco literature and modern Palestinian literature, particularly the ways in which literature has been used by both groups to react to experiences of occupation, internal exile, and ethnic cleansing. Issues of collaboration and resistance, nostalgia, memory, and literary commitment are of particular interest. She recently presented a paper at the March 2023 ACLA titled "Remembering the Ottomans After Oslo: Nationalism and Nostalgia in Modern Palestinian Portrayals of Ottoman Rule."
