She is co-editor of *The Oxford Handbook of Comparative Political Theory* (2020) and author of *Orientalists, Propagandists, and Ilustrados: Filipino Scholarship and the End of Spanish Colonialism* (University of Minnesota Press, 2012). She has published works on political theory and Philippine history in the journals *Philippine Studies*, *Comparative Studies in Society and History*, *The Review of Politics*, *Contemporary Political Theory* and *The International Review of Social History* in addition to chapters various edited volumes. Since 2019, she has, with Anna Tsing, co-directed UCSC's Center for Southeast Asian Coastal Interactions.
