Oumelbanine Zhiri is Professor at the University of California, San Diego, where she teaches French, Arabic, and Comparative literature, as well as World History. She has published books and articles on Leo Africanus and on François Rabelais. More recently, she has published studies on issues pertaining to the early modern cultural history of Europe and North Africa, including travelogues, translation, and treasure seekers. She has recently published a book on Ahmad al-Hajarî with the University of California Press, a project situated at the intersection of travel literature, Orientalism, and science and technology studies.
