Dr. Karen Rose Mathews is an Associate Professor of Art History at the University of Miami. She is a specialist in the visual culture of the medieval and early modern Mediterranean with an emphasis on intercultural relations, the circulation of objects, and artistic exchange across the sea. She published *Conflict, Commerce, and an Aesthetic of Appropriation in the Italian Maritime Cities, 1000-1150* in 2018 and most recently served as lead editor and contributor to the interdisciplinary volume *A Companion to Medieval Pisa* (Brill, 2022). She has also written numerous articles addressing Mediterranean material culture and artistic production, focusing on Byzantium, Italy, and the Mamluk Empire. Her current research project, entitled *Making the Mamluks Mediterranean*, analyzes the integration of the Mamluks into pan-Mediterranean visual culture.
