Matthew B. Lynch is a scholar of religion, history, and literature. He teaches Islamic Studies and history at Oregon St. University and has held teaching positions at Rutgers University, the University of the South, and Bard College. He holds a Ph.D. from the University of North Carolina's Department of Religious Studies and a M.A. from the University of Chicago's Middle Eastern Studies Program. He is currently working on a book manuscript about the Muslim mystic poet and teacher, Mawlana Jalal ad-din Rumi, focusing on the early reception and reproduction of his teachings in Anatolia.
