

Evan S. McAllister is a Ph.D. Candidate in the History Department at Saint Louis University writing a dissertation under the supervision of Professor Thomas F. Madden. McAllister's dissertation examines liturgical quotations in the twelfth-century history of Jerusalem written by Archbishop William of Tyre and considers reader reception and engagement with the text. Prior to coming to SLU, he completed an M.A. in art history at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. His thesis focused on the wall paintings found in the Hospitaller church outside of Jerusalem in Abu Ghosh. While other structures and holy sites in the Levant are well documented in twelfth-century pilgrimages journals, the beautifully painted plaster in the church is strangely absent. In an effort to address this lack of primary sources, his thesis placed the images found in the church within the context of their daily use in the liturgy.
