

Fabien Montcher is assistant professor at St. Louis University. His research focused on the social and intellectual history of cultures of knowledge related to early modern empires and Iberian worlds. His most recent contributions appeared in *17eme siècle*, *Quaderni Storici*, *Erudition and the Republic of Letters*, *Storia della Storiografia*, *Pedralbes*, and *Journal of Early Modern History*. His work has been supported by the Huntington Library, the UCLA Clark Library, the American Philosophical Society, ACLS, and the Institute for Advanced Study in Princeton. While waiting for the publication of his forthcoming monograph on *Mercenaries of Knowledge: The Republic of Letters and the Making of Politics in Early Modern Empires*, Fabien is currently working on a new project entitled *Imperial Bizzarria: A Natural History of Early Modern Conflicts of Sovereignty*.
