

Nathan Van Aken is a first-year graduate student working in Saint Louis University's History department working with Dr. Fabien Montcher and Dr. Claire Gilbert. His research interests include Iberian empires and inquisitions with a focus on how individuals such as *moriscos* and *conversos* interacted with these systems. In particular, he is interested in the ways in which women in these religious communities expressed themselves in the broader Spanish and Portuguese empires, as well as how these women interacted with institutions such as the Spanish and Portuguese Inquisitions. He hopes that his dissertation, once more fully conceived, will consider these women through cross-confessional and trans-imperial lenses, as well as discuss the formulation of public and private life within minority communities in response to intense pressure from these Iberian Inquisitions.
